This is the track that winds down towards the sea and cliffs. Before you get to the cliff edge you will find a track to the left that goes to a long drop toilet - best view from a long drop in WA !  
Continuing on the track to the cliff edge it bears left or right, go left and follow the track down to the bottom of the cliff vis some rough steps. Follow the track round the front and you will see lost of rock ants - that'l be us !

Cross over the style at the parking area and turn right towards the coast. The track goes down across a stram, up the other side and then goes left to another style that you will need to cross. The track (well defined), continues some way before it starts winding down towards the coast / cliff edge.

This is the parking area for most of the people who climb at Willyabrup. It may be crowded. Also dont leave obvious valuables in sight.

Coming from Margaret River go back along Bussell Hwy (north) and then turn left into Cowaramup Bay Road, then turn right into Caves Road, and then left into Willyabrup Road. Measure the distance (Google Maps) or use a GPS, the Willyabrup Road is a dirt road and not well signposted. Follow the dirt road pas 2 X 90Deg bends to the obvious parking area.
